Currituck Crossing's first house is well under way. We've worked with Conner Construction to make design changes that really take advantage of the waterfront location. There are covered upper and lower decks on both sides of the house. A section of the kitchen/dining area has been bumped out, with glass on all sides, giving a 180 degree panorama of the sound, both lakes, and the woodland area to the south.

The view is stunning – even from the first floor you can see so much more than you'd expect from standing on the ground! The family room has windows on both exterior walls, with three large ones facing the sound. Upstairs, the master bedroom and

the large bedroom/family room/media room have plenty of windows with grand views. The upper soundside deck is accessible directly from the master bedroom. I'm envisioning coffee on the private upper deck in the morning, lunch surrounded by glass in the kitchen, and family dinner on the lower deck!
